### **Department Scholarship Funds**

The department has the following scholarship funds for tuition assistance. Scholarships are awarded to dance majors based on financial need, curricular merit, and growth potential in the dance major program. The department does not award full- or half-tuition assistance. Awards are distributed over applicant populations and range from \$500-\$4,000 a year and divided over the semesters; example: a \$1,000 scholarship divided \$500 for Autumn and Spring semester.

**Helen P. Alkire Scholarship Fund** was established in honor of the founding Chair of the Department of Dance. Scholarships from this fund are awarded to majors whose study emphasis is in performance and choreography.

**Stella J. Becker Scholarship Fund** was established in honor of the late OSU alumna, dance teacher, and choreographer from Bexley, Ohio.

**Rosalind Pierson Scholarship Fund** was established in memory of department professor M. Rosalind Pierson, a gifted dancer, teacher and mentor.

**Catherine Elizabeth Woods Dance Scholarship Fund** was established in 2006 to honor the memory of a young dancer and performer. Catherine was the daughter of the School of Music Professor and OSU Marching Band Director, John Woods.

**Wuichet Endowment Fund** was established in honor of Norma Wuichet, the mother of the Dean's Office retired staff member Pat Riechel, to help with the recruitment and retention of deserving students within the arts.

**Aida Cannarsa Snow Endowment Fund** was established to provide need-based scholarships to students interested in the arts (specifically in Art Education, Art, History of Art, Theatre, and Dance).

**Office of Financial Aid Diversity Scholarship Fund assigned to the Department of Dance** provides tuition scholarships to diversified groups in the department. For the field of dance, this includes persons of ethnic origin and males.

### **Requirements**

1. **FAFSA on file with the Office of Student Financial Aid - Tuition scholarships are based on financial need and academic performance, and are only awarded to undergraduate** dance majors. Therefore, you must have a FAFSA on file with Financial Aid at 292-0300, Free Application for Federal Student Aid application.
2. **Must provide a copy of your FAFSA** when you submit this tuition application.
3. **Enrollment and good academic standing** - If awarded a scholarship, you must be enrolled each semester covered by the funding period and remain in good academic standing. Academic probation could mean that your scholarship tuition is revoked.
4. **Must reapply each year** – Dept tuition assistance and FAFSA applications are due each February for the next academic year. Dept scholarships are not automatically renewed.
