General Duties of Dance Adjunct Faculty include:

- Instruction and assessment of student progress which includes, but is not limited to, grading, keeping required attendance records, and keeping syllabi current, accurate and relevant.
- Attend a minimum of two faculty meetings per year and report to the Dean on a regular basis.
- Perform other related duties as assigned by the Dean of the School

Opportunities to choreograph are possible for addition compensation. Contemporary/ Musical Theater/Broadway or Commercial Jazz Choreographer Needed. Cast has already been selected and Rehearsals times are already set for Monday nights from 6:30-8:00pm. Rehearsals are scheduled for 10 weeks. Performance dates are May 1-5.

Qualifications: A Masters degree in related field and teaching experience in higher education are preferred. An appropriate Bachelors degree is required and/or extensive performing and diverse teaching experience will be considered. Preference will be given to candidates who are available to teach both sections.
