The Dance Department at Hollins University invites applications for an Instructor of Dance & Assistant Director of the MFA Program starting in July 2012. This is a renewable, multi-year, non-tenure-track appointment with a modern dance focus.

Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in dance, specifically modern dance technique and improvisation. Must offer expertise in at least three areas of undergraduate and graduate core curriculum: undergraduate/graduate seminar, dance history, contemporary creative practices/processes, performance studies, dance and the environment, or dance technology/dance for the camera. Must also be able to discuss dance as a corporeal knowledge, cultural language, imaginative expression, and performance art. Experience in writing and a readiness to participate in all administrative, strategic, and programmatic activities of the department are essential. Will serve as coordinator for the undergraduate program and assistant director for the Hollins/American Dance Festival MFA program (includes summer appointments at ADF). Position will also maintain and/or cultivate relationships with professional associations and area schools/teachers to facilitate visibility and recruitment, and maintain visible profile and active program of scholarly and/or creative activity.

Successful applicants must have a MFA, MA, or PhD with performance background and teaching experience in higher education, or substantial professional performing career.

Qualified applicants should submit a letter of application, curriculum vitae, and three current letters of recommendation (at least two of which must speak to teaching ability) to Hollins University, Dance Dept., Attn: Search, P.O. Box 9621, Roanoke, VA 24020. Review of applications will begin immediately, and will continue until the position is filled.
